

Patient and bandage care instructions

Please restrict activity to allow healing and protect the bandage.

- Limit walks to short 5-10 minute, on-leash, calm outings. Do not allow extra activity, running, rough play.
- Please keep bandage protected, clean and dry. Use a plastic bootie to cover the bandage when going outside. Remove bootie once back indoors.
- If the bandage gets wet, please call and make an appointment for bandage replacement.
- If you notice the bandage becoming loose or slipping or any toe swelling, please make an appointment for recheck and bandage replacement.
- Your pet should wear a cone collar at all times when a bandage is present to protect it from damage by chewing/licking.
- Recheck and bandage removal should be done within 5 days or as directed by the doctor.
